

Rustic Pavements

Description

Forms and colours that evoke natural stone, gathered for soil rustic, contemporary or modern.

Rustic pavement are mainly used for swimming pool surrounds, on open or covered terraces or pedestrian footpaths. They can also be used as finishing on the concrete edges of swimming pools. Colours include sand, light grey, dark grey, terracotta, red and brown. Rustic pavings are for outdoor use and come in a range of sizes (220 x 220 mm, 300 x 450 mm, 450 x 450 mm, 450 x 600 mm, 450 x 670 mm and 600 x 600 mm), which can all be cut to size.
